We are in a position to offer the following:

- at least 10 significant financial awards each year;
- information about workshops willing to provide short term work experience placements to experienced students.

Awards are not intended to cover tuition fees or normal living expenses, but, for example, could be made to underwrite a specific task or project, or to provide tools or materials. We wish particularly to support those with motivation and ability. Repeat applications from successful candidates will only be considered on receipt of written and photographic information about the work undertaken using the initial grant. Information about award winners will be included where possible on our website, providing useful publicity.

Applications will be assessed annually, the closing date being 31 March. Successful applicants will be informed within a month of this date. Late applicants will be asked to resubmit at the next round of awards.

10. Achievements during current course

Give an outline of the work you have undertaken so far during the course.

11. What do you wish to apply for:

i. Financial support

Give information (including total sum costings) about what you wish to finance, ie purchase of tools, wood, books; funding travel, further study, and why this is required.

ii. Workshop placements

Indicate if you wish to receive details of workshops offering placements, and the sort of work you would like to undertake – i.e. making, restoration, special interest in a particular instrument.

12. Give reasons to support your application

Give details of how you think the above will help your studies. Complete the section in no more than 150 words, using a separate sheet if necessary.

13. How do you fund your studies

Give brief details of your sources of income, ie grants, part-time work, parental support.

14. Reference in support of your application

This should be completed by a college tutor, or your employer if you are apprenticed, and can be on a separate sheet.

15. Position, signature, date

Details of the person who has given the reference.
